



Apple Find My

After you add your lemno bike as one of your Find My items, you'll be able to locate it on a map, play a sound if it's nearby, and enable Lost Mode – which will notify you if your lost bike is found.


How to Connect My bike

You can pair your bike with the Find My app on your iOS device in a few simple steps:


1. Make sure your bike is powered on.



2. Open the Find My app on your iOS device. On the Items tab, tap Add Item.



3. Tap Other Supported Item.




How to Connect My bike

4. Once the app is in search mode, hold the left button on the bike for 5 seconds.



5. Tap Connect once your phone has discovered your bike. Follow the onscreen instructions in the app. You can also name your bike.



How to Disable Find My Tracking Temporarily

After you paired with your bike, you can disable Find My tracking temporarily without removing your bike from Find My app.

1. Make sure your bike is powered on.



2. Press the left button for 10 seconds. You will hear a sound that signals the tracking is disabled. The location of your bike will not update and the 'Play sound' function will no longer be usable in Find My app.




3. To enable Find My tracking again, make sure your bike is powered on, press the left button for 5 seconds, and you will hear a different sound that signals Find My tracking is enabled.





If you find your bike missing, enable Lost Mode to locate your bike by following these steps:

1. Select your bike from the Items list.
2. Tap Enable under Lost Mode.




3. Read WHAT WILL HAPPEN? and tap Continue.



4. Enter your phone number or email address, and tap Activate to turn on Lost Mode.




▲ **NOTE** If your bike is locatable, other iOS users can help identify your bike by tapping Identify Found Item on their Find My app.



How to Disable Lost Mode

You can disable Lost Mode when your bike is found in a few simple steps:




1. Select your bike from the Items list.
2. Tap Enabled under Lost Mode.
3. Tap Turn Off Lost Mode. You have now disabled Lost Mode.



How to Remove My Bike

If you no longer own the bike, remove it from your Find My network by following these steps:

1. Select your bike from the Items list.
2. Scroll to the bottom and tap Remove Item.
3. On the Remove Item screen, tap Remove. Your bike will be removed from your items.



How to Restore Factory Settings

Restoring factory settings allows you to unpair your bike if your bike is offline when you remove your bike from Find My app.

1. Make sure your bike is powered on.



2. Quickly short press the left button 10 times and then long press the left button for at least 10 seconds. You will hear a sound that signals your bike has been restored to factory setting successfully.
